HOW TO APPLY

- Be a San Francisco resident, and
- Aged 60+, or younger disabled adult, and
- Having difficulty paying your rent

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Income no more than \$45,180 per year for one person and \$61,320 for a couple
- Lack stable housing or at risk of homelessness
- Not currently receiving any other housing subsidies
- Participates in the program and follows subsidy guidelines

WHAT TO BRING TO APPLY

- Proof of Income, and assets (e.g. Bank statements, SSA/SSI letters, income take statements)
- Provide proof of residency (e.g. utility bills, phone bills, benefit letters)
- California ID or Driver's License or Passport
- Medical or Disability Letter
- Lease agreement with landlord
- W9 form completed by landlord
