



# Catholic Charities Family Housing Assistance Program

## About

Catholic Charities Family Housing Assistance provides homeless and low-income families with ongoing monthly rental subsidies accompanied by intensive case management services to rapidly transition homeless families into housing and to prevent low-income families from becoming homeless.

The program provides strength-based case management and comprehensive supportive services in a home-based setting to aid families in independent living. Through Family Housing Assistance, clients can locate and maintain safe, permanent housing, receive guidance in meeting educational and professional goals, learn self-sufficiency skills, organize their expenses and manage money, and develop solid relationships both in their families and the community. Family Housing Services is a partnership with the San Francisco Department of Homelessness & Supportive Housing.
