## About

The Rental Assistance Programs seek to prevent evictions through back rent assistance, landlord mediation, and information and referral to appropriate community agencies. Additionally, they support individuals and families with security deposits and first month's rent for a new sustainable unit they've identified and plan to lease.

Operating in collaboration with other community service providers, these programs streamline the intake process for low-income, at-risk families and individuals in San Francisco. The programs are funded by the San Francisco Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development (MOHCD) and the Department of Health and Human Services (HSH) as a part of the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) collaborative.
