St. Vincent's School for Boys (St. Vincent's) is a supervised residential shelter program that can serve up to 40 boys ages 7 to 17. St. Vincent's meets the unique needs of unaccompanied children from all backgrounds and improves their quality of life during their initial transition from their countries of origin to the United States. The program has a crisis team to handle challenging intakes, serving the whole child through school academics, comprehensive medical and mental health care, legal assistance, and recreation. The program provides successful growth and development for the youth to change their lives.

Services

- Home-like environment and residence with staff supervised support 24 hours daily
- On-going mental health, medical, and case management
- Family, group and individual therapy
- Academic instruction, assessment, and support
- English language learning
- Physical education and recreational activities
- Legal Services
- Family/Guardian reunification support
