About

Catholic Charities Treasure Island Child Development Center (TICDC) is a licensed childcare and preschool facility staffed by professionally trained educators, serving families that represent the rich diversity of the San Francisco region. TICDC provides comprehensive family support and full-time childcare through its infant, toddler, and preschool programs, serving the Treasure Island community as well as families throughout San Francisco and the greater East Bay area.

TICDC is a multilingual early learning center serving families from diverse language backgrounds. The program fosters each child's home language and early literacy development through participation in the Tandem Books rotation, which provides families with new books on a weekly basis. Monthly visits from the San Francisco Public Library Bookmobile further enrich the program through read-alouds and hands-on literacy experiences.

TICDC programs emphasize play-based, experiential learning that provides children with meaningful opportunities to explore expressive arts and natural sciences. The center intentionally integrates early academic concepts into classroom lessons and activities in developmentally appropriate ways. Early academic skills are embedded within play-based experiences, including songs, stories, games, and hands-on learning opportunities.
