Aging Support Services - Long Term Rental Subsidy Program

Program Overview

Are you facing challenges covering your rent in San Francisco?

Older adults and adults with disabilities face an ongoing struggle to maintain stable housing in San Francisco due to increasing rents and a limited supply of safe, affordable housing. This program, funded in full by the San Francisco Department of Disability & Aging Services, prevents homelessness and promotes housing stabilization by providing housing subsidies for older adults and adults with disabilities in unstable housing situations.

If our Long Term Rental Subsidies Program is not suitable for you, our Intake Specialist collaborates closely with various city departments and community agencies. They are ready to assist you in accessing alternative services and programs to meet your needs.

Program Requirements

- Aged 60 and above, or
- Aged 18 to 59 with a disability, and
- At an income level of 50% of AMI or below, and
- Lacking stable housing, and at risk of eviction, and
- Homelessness, and
- A San Francisco resident
- Lack of stable housing or at risk of homelessness
- Not currently receiving any other housing subsidies
- Participates in the program and follows subsidy guidelines

What to Bring to Apply

- Proof of Income, and assets (e.g. Bank statements, SSA/SSI letters, income take statements)
- Provide proof of residency (e.g. utility bills, phone bills, benefit letters)
- California ID or Driver's License or Passport
- Medical or Disability Letter
- Lease agreement with landlord
